

Attendance

Following information we have received from Sheffield City Council Attendance and Inclusion for Schools, we wish to remind you that:



Holidays should not be taken in term time. From September 2021 schools are advised that fines will be issued as per pre Covid rules. Therefore all holidays will be unauthorised and subject to holiday fines from Sheffield City Council.



First day of absence. Please contact school on the first day that your child is absent from school to inform us why your child will not be attending. Medical evidence may be requested.



Appointments. Where possible please try and plan any medical appointments out of school time. If you have to make an appointment in school time please make them for as late in the morning or afternoon as possible so that your child will receive both attendance marks for the day. Medical evidence must be provided.



Attendance below 90%. Children with attendance below 90% are classed as persistent absentees. This means that their attendance will be closely monitored by school and the Local Authority. School monitor all children with falling attendance.
