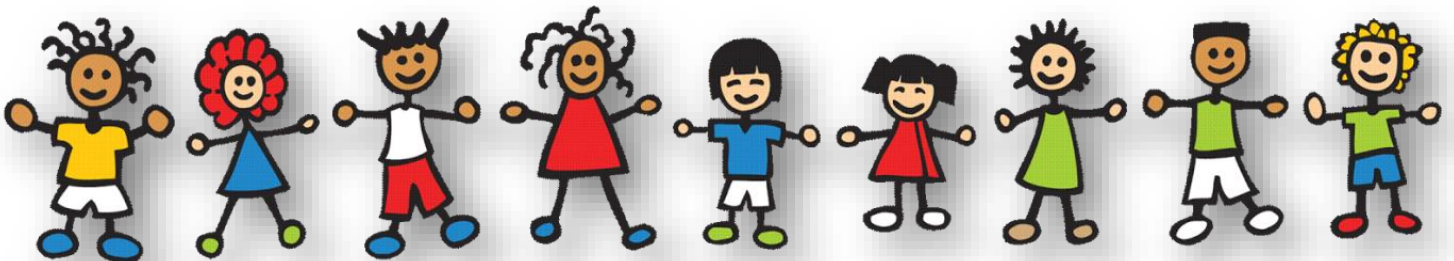


**Full Re-Opening of School  
Monday 8<sup>th</sup> March 2021**



Dear Families

We are pleased to be able to welcome everyone back to school on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> March. The guidance informs us about how to balance and minimise any risks from coronavirus and we must follow this guidance. The system of controls provides schools with a set of principles and if schools follow this advice they will effectively minimise risks. We have addressed these controls with a very thorough Risk Assessment which reflects advice from **Public Health** and the **Local Authority**.

Schools must do everything possible to minimise the number of contacts between children, staff and parents. Our school will be working in “**Class Bubbles**” in order to achieve this. The changes to the start and finish of the day, the reducing the length of lunchtimes will ensure that the school is minimising risk however there has been **no reduction to teaching time** in fact there is specific time for “**catch up**” within the new school day.

#### How will we do this:-

- Children to remain wherever possible in their own “**Class Bubbles**”.
- **Staggered starts and finishes**- to reduce congestion and gatherings as much as possible.
- Parents need to be punctual in arriving and picking up so that “**Class Bubbles**” are protected.
- Only **1 parent** to drop off and pick up.
- **Staggered** lunchtimes and playtimes.
- Junior children will go straight into class in the morning not go onto the yard.
- Staff will be arranging classrooms to facilitate forward facing classrooms wherever possible.
- Continue with a **robust hand and respiratory routines** -washing hands more frequently throughout the day.
- Continue with **enhanced cleaning routines** around classrooms and shared areas.
- No **Breakfast Club**- until the risk assessment allows
- No **After School Clubs** – until the risk assessment allows
- No **Lunchtime Clubs**- until the risk assessment allows
- No **Healthy Snack Shop** for KS2 – until the risk assessment allows
- No **Toddler Group** until further notice
- No **Mobile Phones**.
- No **parents in school** other than dropping off and picking up FS and KS1 children.
- Indoor shoes will no longer be needed.
- Parent meetings through **appointments only**.
- Children must not attend school if they have COVID symptoms or who have someone in their household who does.
- Parents need to inform school immediately of the results of a COVID Test.
- No school meal option for full-time nursery children. Parents to provide a packed lunch from home.

















#### Attendance Expectations

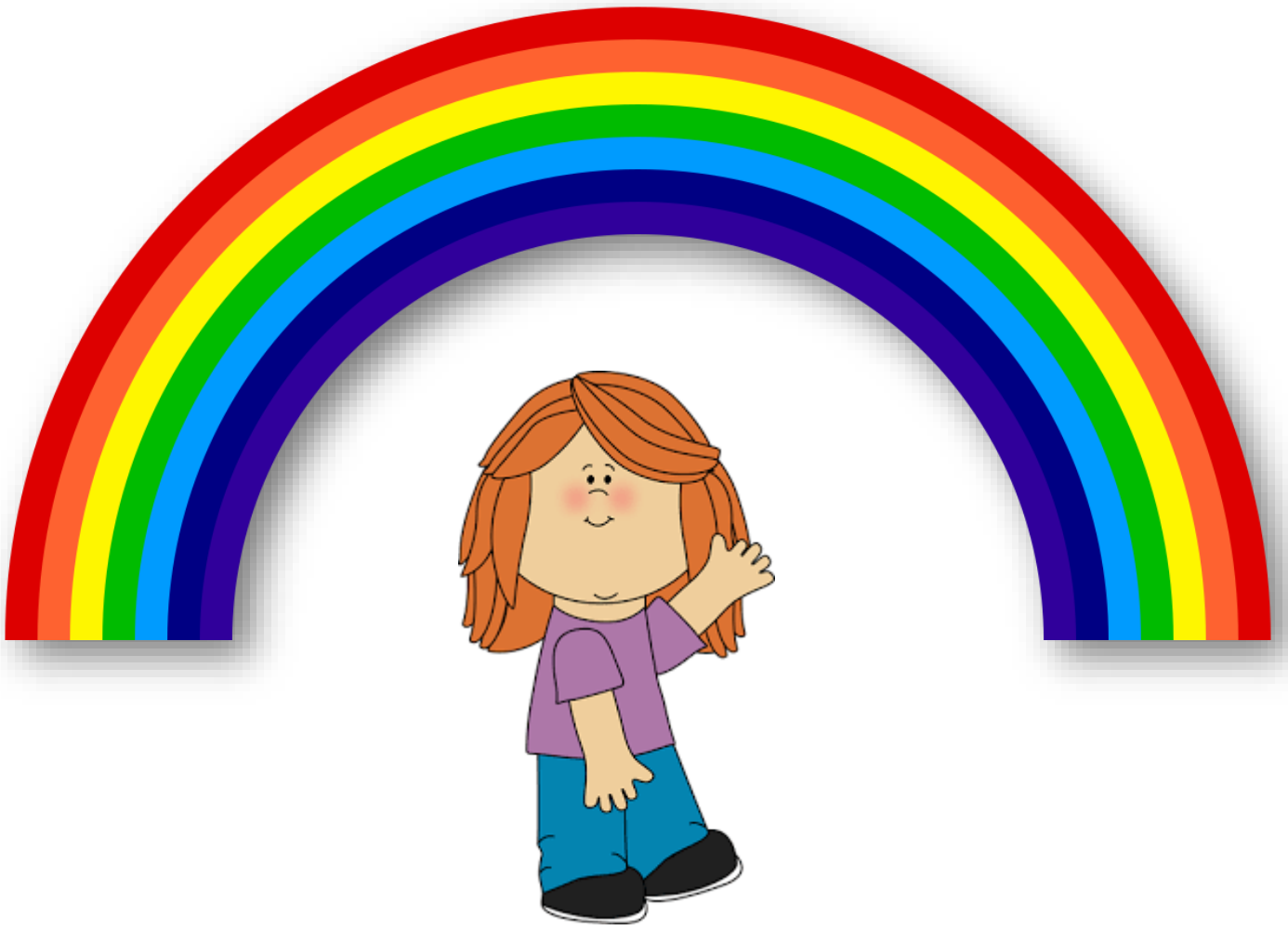
- All children are expected to attend school
